Program Description The Network Technology Certificate program is designed to train a technician to be capable of installing, troubleshooting, upgrading, and repairing computers and installing computer networks. Courses cover computer software, hardware and networking essentials. At the completion of the program a student should be able to prepare for and take the A+ Certification Exam. Students will also learn and gain practice in the topics covered by the Network+ Certification Exam and Server + Exam. The curriculum is carefully constructed and kept up to date with the ongoing advice of our advisory committee. This technology certificate program is the first year of the EdCC Network Technology ATA degree program.

Credit/Grade Requirements The Network Technology Certificate program is awarded upon a student's completion of the required **61** credits from the *General Education/Related Instruction Requirements and Program Requirements* as outlined. A minimum of 30 credits or one-third, whichever is less, of the required credits must have been received from Edmonds Community College. Students are required to maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 in all college-level courses.
