Program Description The UNIX/Linux Fundamentals Certificate is designed for students aspiring to gain fundamental understanding of the Linux and UNIX operating systems, their common utilities and shell programming. Credit/Grade Requirements All required credits must be earned at Edmonds Community College. Students are required to maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 in all college-level courses as well as a minimum grade point average of 2.5 within the program requirements.
